Thursday September 3rd – Class & Locker Registration: Freshmen & Sophomores (Freshman students who attended orientation previous evening do not have to come in on this date.)

Dear Parent and Guardians,

Hello this is LaSalle High School Principal Gregg Fettig. A copy of this message will be posted on the “Headlines” section of the district and LaSalle High School Website that is labeled, “LHS Fall 2020 Return to School Information Center.” The purpose of this message is to communicate with you about important class registration information for students who are planning to attend traditional face to face instruction this fall. Seniors and juniors can register for classes and lockers on Wednesday September 2nd from 8:30 am – 3:00 PM. Then in the evening on Wednesday September 2nd, at 5:15 PM in the HS Gym, we will hold a “Freshmen Orientation” for any freshman students and parents to attend to get information about traditional face to face instruction in our high school building this fall, take a building tour, and students who attend this orientation would get their class schedules and locker assignments. Then on Thursday September 3rd, any freshmen who did not attend freshmen orientation the previous evening, along with sophomores who are planning to attend traditional face to face instruction this fall, could register for classes from 8:30 AM – 3:00 PM. We ask if any students have any textbooks from last year that they please return these books when coming in for registration. If students need to make a schedule change, we ask to for students or parents to please email our guidance counselor Mrs. Connie Olsen at colsen@eupschools.org. Emailing Mrs. Olsen would be the preferred method, or you could call the high school office and schedule an appointment with her. Also, on Wednesday September 2nd at 7:30 Pm, We are having a student/ parent meeting for any junior or senior students who are taking CTE Vocational Classes at Cheboygan this year. This meeting with held in the gym and will discuss important topics and expectations related to students riding the bus to and from Cheboygan and information regarding students attending these classes. We ask all students and parents when attending any of these events on our school campus to please wear a mask when entering our building and to please practice social distancing. Finally, we are asking parents to complete an online student information form that is located on the school district and Lasalle High School website under the LHS Fall 2020 Return to School Information Center. This online form is labeled “LaSalle High School Student Information Form.” We are asking parents to complete this form as soon as possible to confirm important information regarding your child. We ask if you have multiple students in our building, please complete the form for each student. If you do not have internet access and are not able to access this information, please call the high school office at 643-8800

and please leave a message and we can get this information from you. Again, the first day of school for traditional face to face learn is Tuesday September 8th. Doors will open at 7:40 am and students will be expected to report to their first hour classes beginning at 8:00 am. We are looking forward to getting students back to school!
