- What is EUP Virtual Online Collaborative:
 - A Regional Collaborative which includes DeTour, DATA, Les Cheneaux, Pickford, Rudyard, St Ignace, and Whitefish school districts
 - 284 K-12 students
 - 29 EUP teachers
 - How did this program start? Ideas Last Fall 2019?
 - Semester commitment – Drop date of September 18th
 - Students are responsible for internet access – Local Access at Brevort Township Hall, St. Ignace Township Hall, School Parking Lot, Lambert Center - Reservation



Are Students Still LHS Students?

- Yes, they can attend events, participate in sports, extracurricular activities, etc.
- Students are held to same academically eligibility standards and requirements as if they were in school.
- Students will still have access to school related assessments like PSAT, SAT, M-STEP, NWEA, etc. that students would be required to take.

What is in the folders?

Learning Management System – CANVAS – Online Platform for Learning

Course Content - Accelerate Education – Online Curriculum

- Teachers will facilitate online curriculum, learning, answer questions, etc.
- Teachers are currently doing trainings to get them familiar with this system!

Student Login Information into Canvas/ Accelerated ED Login

- Student usernames and passwords – What are they? What is my student email address?
- Student email addresses and passwords – School Gmail account. Students will need to sign into school g-mail account and then login to Canvas.
 - [Login – St. Ignace Area Schools District Webpage – Under Site Shortcuts – Login To school student email account, then click on “Canvas Student & Teacher Login.”](#)
 - Check your school email daily! Also when your classes are assigned, you need to login each day and work on classwork for all classes each day.
 - Complete Two - Way communication with teachers

How long should students work on classes a day

- Students should login to each class and work on course work for each class everyday.

Recommended Daily Activity Times

Pre-K	20 minutes/day	60 minutes/day	3-5 minutes
K	30 minutes/day	90 minutes/day	3-5 minutes
1-2	45 minutes/day	90 minutes/day	5-10 minutes
3-5	60 minutes/day	120 minutes/day	10-15 minutes
6-8	Class: 15 minutes/day Total: 90 minutes/day	Class: 30 minutes/day Total: 180 minutes/day	1 subject area or class
9-12	Class: 20 minutes/day Total: 120 minutes/day	Class: 45 minutes/day Total: 270 minutes/day	1 subject area or class

Who do I contact for Help?

How do grades work?

- Grades will be issued by teachers of the online courses.
- In Canvas there is gradebook that students should be able to see of how they are doing on their coursework and assessments.
- Marking period grades and semester grades will be updated in Powerschool for our students. A mentor will be assigned to work with online teacher to track grades, progress, and academic eligibility if necessary.

* We are working on the flow of how this process will work!

Scheduling of Classes ?

- What will my schedule of classes look like?
 - Scheduling will focus on keeping students on track to graduate.
 - If a student has an IEP, they will still be supported with their IEP. Mrs. Martin is our HS Online Special Education Teacher will be a mentor for students and for some students based on their schedule, will be teaching them online.
 - 9th and 10th grade students – focused more on requirements
 - 11th and 12th grade students – have more electives and will have to select from list.
 - After today's meeting we will break up into groups. Mr. Fettig will meet with students/parents of 9th and 10th grade, Mrs. Olsen will meet with students of 11th & 12th grade to finalize schedules.

When will classes start?

- We are working with the EUPISD and the hope is next week to start classes - Monday! Login to your account and see if you can see your classes.
- Assignment for Students? Once classes are assigned, look through the interface? How do things work?
- Again students should check their daily school email accounts for any information!
