Played football and basketball at LaSalle before being drafted into the Navy Air Corps in February 1944. Played basketball at Newberry College in Newberry, South Carolina (when studying for officer's ranking). Played JV Basketball and ran track at University of South Carolina and in June of 1946 he earned his ensign ranking. Entered Albion College in fall of 1946 where he played JV basketball and ran track (was MIAA half mile track champion). He graduated from Albion in 1948 (and married Peggy Dolese on June 19th of that same year). Moie went on to Michigan Law School (graduating in June 1951) during which time he participated in St. Ignace independent baseball and basketball teams.

Moie moved back to St. Ignace to practice law in 1951 and has since been an outstanding contributor to the community as well as the St. Ignace Area Schools.

His dedication to the Saints and his positions held as Kiwanis Club member (1951-present); chairman of the Municipal Golf Club (1957-2002);
